MONTHLY REPORT  
February 2002**

**GENERAL ACTIVITIES**

1. For the month of February, we had two general meetings, Fire chief meeting and one supervisor meeting. February was preparing for Public Safety Diving class and organizing the up coming search and rescue training. The Ice Rescue classes had to be cancelled due to lack of cold weather. All coordinators are checking all the equipment for replacement and upgrading. We are starting our planning for water safety programs for the schools in Boone and Kenton County. Each department head has looked at all the equipment that is needed now and is to be budgeted for the new fiscal year. Various types of diving equipment has been inspected for possible failures and the annual maintenance for the equipment is in the process of being sent out for repair or general replacement. Our budget preparation has been on going since January. The end of the year report is being finalized and should be ready by mid March. All of the boats have been checked for yearly maintenance and repair. There were no actual details for February although we did have a disregard concerning a Jumper off the Suspension bridge.
