MONTHLY REPORT  
June, 2002**

**GENERAL ACTIVITIES**

1. **In June we had two general team meeting. 218 & 219 are now docked at Villa Hills Marina. The new generator has been installed on 219.**

**SECURITY & EMS SUPPORT**

2. **Assisted the Coast Guard, Ohio Department of Natural Resources and provided exhort for B&B Riverboats for the “Underground Railroad/Freedom” exhibition in Covington and Cincinnati.**

**TRAINING**

3. **Our public safety diving and our S & R courses have been completed. Out of 5 divers, 2 finished the courses successfully. Our EMTs also participated in a mock drill during this training. This training emphasized different medical emergencies that may occur during dive training. Our new crewmen also had a “hands-on” training class aboard 219. Our EMT instructors taught a CPR/First Aid class to 24 individuals at Orsanco.**

**RESCUES**

4. **There were 2 boater assists during our normal boat patrol one boat was mid stream and the other was adrift near the Covington shore line. Each boat had engine failure the boats and passengers were towed to Watertown Marina and Riverside Four.**

**PUBLIC RELATIONS**

5. **We have developed a float plan for boaters and this has been posted on our web site and will be distributed to boaters during boat patrol hours. Our new brochure has been completed and is ready for distribution. We participated in the annual “Riversweep” and deployed 3 boats to 4 locations.**
