GENERAL ACTIVITIES

Details and Rescues

Williamstown Lake, Grant Co.

1. EM requested help fisherman had been hit by other pleasure craft, divers found the male victim in 13 feet of water 67 feet out from the dock area.

Kenton County:

2. Requested to Latonia reference drowning of young boy, the boy was found in banklick creek before we arrived on the scene.
3. 24' boat on shore would not start 2 people aboard, towed boat.
4. 21' boat adrift without power 4 people aboard engine failure, towed boat.

Boone County:

5. 07-08-04, Vehicle had rolled in a lake at Porter Plantation, 2 children were in the vehicle construction crews rescued the children we pulled the SUV out of the lake.
6. 32' bayliner 4 adults, 3 children, Noticed a person waving a distress flag the boat was without power a storm was about to overturn the boat and slamming the boat against the bank, we tied the boat to ours and towed them to safety.
7. 18' boat drifting near the shore 2 adults aboard, engine failure towed boat.
8. 22' Glastron boat adrift mid stream, barge approaching the craft we quickly tied them to our boat and towed them to safety, 4 adults aboard, the boat had spun a prop.
9. Recovered a floating propane tank mid stream 1/4 full, secured the tank.
10. Were requested to help a commercial vessel thru the Aurora area, we warned the pleasure craft of the approaching barge.
