**GENERAL ACTIVITIES**

1. Various team and committee meetings.
2. Boat 218 and 219 is in the water and in service at Villa Hills Marina.
3. Reorganized the dive truck, distributing the weight of the equipment was the goal.
4. Weekly river report for channel 9 and the Ky. Post, this report advises the water conditions on the river.
5. Boat Patrol has started.

**(Crew consist of 1 boat operator, 2 EMT's and 1 crew person)**

Most day light hours are spent in Boone County while the night time hours are spent in Covington and Kenton County. Also considerations are made if there is little or no boat traffic or weather conditions will affect the length of boat patrol.

**Training**

1. Diver re-certification is required and on going, this training re-certification is completed in stages not taking to many divers out of service.
2. Drop camera, boat, crew and various types of diver training is scheduled for July

**Public Relations**

1. Water Safety program at Toy's R Us, gave out safety brochures, Frisbees to the children and taught the children how to use a throw bags to save people that are in trouble. Emphasized the use of life jackets.
2. Working on handouts to be distributed to try to gain more volunteers.
3. Coming events Home Depot safety fair and various other safety fairs in Kenton County.

**Details and Rescues**

1. Grant County: Drowning in Williamstown lake, Grant Co. EM requested help that a 25 year old male had drowned in the middle of the lake, we found the victim 11 hours later 45 feet out in approximately 9 feet of water.
2. Kenton County, City of Covington: EMS and diver support for boat races June 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>.
3. Kenton County: 24' boat adrift, equipment failure, 3 people aboard, towed boat.
4. Boone County: 21' boat adrift, bad gas, 2 people aboard, towed boat.
5. Boone County: Fishing boat two people aboard engine failure, towed to North Bend.
6. Boone County: 20' ski boat, adrift one person aboard (DUI) Hamilton Co. arrested the subject and removed him from the boat; we towed the boat to Mariners Landing for Hamilton Co. Sheriff department.
