GENERAL ACTIVITIES

1. Various team and committee meetings

Details

1. Cave Run Lake, Morehead, 4 dive teams worked two days trying to locate 1 male subject that had driven his pickup truck into the lake. Our divers were requested to help locate the subject, we found the subject 30 hours after arriving at the lake. The truck and victim was located around 120 feet from shore in over 50 feet of water with a water temperature of 37 degrees. The extraction of the victim and vehicle was extremely difficult. All expenses for fuel, and food were paid by Rowan County.
