

**BOONE COUNTY WATER RESCUE
MONTHLY REPORT
June 2005**

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

1. General team meetings, supervisors meeting, general dive and boat maintenance. Preparing for special events on the river. Scheduling boat patrol, end of the year equipment repair and replacement.

Training

1. In house CEU training for our EMT's each month on going.
2. Heat exhaustion and heat related injury training do's and don't'.
3. Last phase of Public safety & P.A.D.I., diver search and rescue training (all training is in 0 visibility) beginning 6-13 class room on warrants for diving, 6-14 beginning search pattern training, 6-15 pool session introduction to all area's of search and recovery, 6-16 lake training in the morning at Camp Ernst lake search patterns and comfort levels of diving including vehicle and aircraft inspection under the water, 6-16 in the evening at Big Bone landing training in patterns and evidence collection and on 6-17 the conclusion of S&R at Petersburg landing with river search patterns and underwater vehicle inspection.
4. Side Scan sonar and drop camera training.

Details

Rescues\drowning\boating assist

1. Campbell County: drowning assisted Campbell Co. Water Rescue with the side scan sonar in locating victim that was running from Hamilton Co. authorities subject last seen trying to swim across the Ohio River.
2. Kenton County: boat sinking 2 aboard, towed boat to safe area where the owner could remove the boat.
3. Boone County: Boat adrift 2 people aboard, fuel pump on the boat failed. Towed boat to safety.
4. Boone County: Barge hit boat, capsizing the boat and throwing 1 male and 1 female away from the barge, the boat was upside down and sinking. Towed the boat to Constance Marina and removed.
5. Boone County: Boat adrift mid stream, 2 aboard, towed boat to nearest harbor.
