MONTHLY REPORT**

May 2006

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

1. General team meetings, supervisor meeting, fire chiefs meeting.
2. Diving equipment has been checked and all gear is safe.
3. The air station update has been completed.
4. Boat 218 general maintenance and repair has been completed and is in the water at Villa Hills Marina.
5. Boat 219 is in the water at Villa Hills Marine, 219 will be configured to carry EMS equipment, and dive equipment, drop camera equipment, and side scan sonar equipment.
6. Preparing to install all wireless and computer equipment on all boats and Squad.
7. Boat 220 is being reconfigured to use both the side scan sonar and drop camera equipment on going.
8. New life jackets have been issued to all members.
9. End of the year purchasing is completed.

Training

1. In house CEU training for EMT's 2nd Thursday of each month on going, 4th Thursday of each month in department head training as needed.
2. 2006 training of 5 new divers is on going.

Rescues

1. Kenton County: Covington 3 adults and 5 children adrift lost power secured assisted in restarting there engine and followed them to assure the boat was in good working order.
2. Kenton County: requested to assisted commercial vessels thru the bridges in Covington.
3. Boone County: requested to assist commercial vessel thru the area of Aurora and Petersburg area
4. Kenton County: Villa Hills boat engine failure towed boat to Villa Hills 4 adults aboard
5. Kenton County: Ludlow boat engine failure towed boat and 4 adults to Villa Hills Marina.

Drowning

Boone County: Victim jumped off I-275 Bridge upon hitting the water the victim was driven into the river bottom 2 divers dislodged the victim and was brought aboard Dearborn County's rescue boat, and transported to Petersburg landing to the Coroner.
