

**BOONE COUNTY WATER RESCUE
MONTHLY REPORT**

June 2007

GENERAL ACTIVITIES

1. Two team meetings.
2. The last phase of the building project on going.
3. Assisted Seth Foundation reference a drowning in Anchorage Alaska (side scan sonar and ROV guidance).
4. Boat 219 will be out of service most of July for engine replacement, painting, replacing the A/C and lettering.
5. Water safety talks and demonstrations, Independence safety fair June 13th Day care center approx. 50 children
6. Beachgrove center demonstrations of equipment and display June 16th,
7. Participated in Land, Sea, & Air day June 20th at St. Elizabeth Hospital with the National Guard, Covington Fire, Transcare, our role in emergency care.
8. Water Safety display at Coney Island for Verst Logistics Inc. June 23rd.
9. WXIX channel 19 requested overview of team activities for the 4th of July and the discovery of a 200' X45' boat laying in over 30' of water. The Cincinnati Museum of Natural history may explore the boat as historical point of interest on the Ohio River.

Kenton County

10. Visual searches for the victim that jumped off the I-75 are ongoing. Scheduling crews weekly ongoing.

Boone County

11. Runabout 1 adult & 2 children aboard, engine problems towed boat to safety.
12. Hamilton County water patrol 18' boat, 2 officers aboard, engine overheated around Stringtown towed boat to Mariners Landing.

Campbell County

13. Assisted Campbell Co. Water Rescue 100' houseboat without power at River City harbor towed to Watertown Marina.

14. Drowning in Ohio River at the Riverside public landing, the victim was swimming with a friend and drowned approximately 200 feet downstream from the public ramp. The victim drowned around 5:00pm and was found using side scan sonar, verified by the drop camera and divers made the recovery. Also located a vehicle at the end of the launching ramp in 12' of water.
