Campbell County

- 1. 2 men drown in the middle of the river just downstream from the Little Miami River, we found both subjects with side scan sonar and placed the underwater camera and buoyed targets on the subjects, and Campbell County Water Rescue divers recovered the victims. Total time for the recovery was 28 hours.**
