Second Person Dies From Boating Accident

CARROLL COUNTY, Ky. -- A second person has died from a boating accident on the Kentucky River in Carroll County, **News 5** reported.

Lydia Stethen, 63, of New Castle, Ky., died at a hospital Thursday morning. The cause of death was ruled as an anoxic brain injury. Her death is being investigated as an accident, police said.

Stethen and two others were fishing Monday when their boat capsized at the mouth of the Ohio River.

The other victim, 58-year-old Joe Clark, of Oldham County, Ky., went under the water and never resurfaced, witnesses said. His body was recovered Monday night by the Boone County dive team.

The third person on the boat escaped injury.
