

Dead Boaters Identified

The Ohio River boaters who were missing and then found dead were identified as Jerome Colley, Jr., 40, of Cincinnati and Rudolph Crandall, 49, of New Richmond.

The two boaters went missing after an accident on the Ohio River Friday evening.

The accident was reported on the Ohio River under the I-275 bridge near Kellogg Avenue just after 8 p.m.

The empty speedboat was recovered downstream from Coney Island by rescue crews on Friday night.

According Captain Dale Appel of the Boone County Water Rescue, recovery crews located the first victim early Saturday morning.

Dive crews from Campbell County were able to recover the victim.

Boone County Water Rescue located the body of the second victim just before noon on Saturday.
